

E911 JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

JUNEAU COUNTY

In as much as the County of Juneau, represented by the Department of Emergency Government Committee, has assumed planning of 911 service in Juneau County, by authority of the Juneau County board of Supervisors,

and

WHEREAS, Juneau County and the municipalities located within boundaries of Juneau County will be implementing an E911 System for purposes of providing emergency services to residents of these municipalities, including fire fighting, law enforcement, ambulance, medical and other emergency services:

and

WHEREAS, Chapter 392, Laws of 1977, which became effective on May 24th, 1978, created Sec. 146.70 Wis.Stats., entitled "State-Wide Emergency Services number;"

and

WHEREAS, Subsection (9), "Joint Powers Agreement," requires that in implementing an E911 system as is being done in Juneau County, Municipalities shall annually enter into a joint powers agreement, which agreement shall be applicable on a daily basis and which shall provide that if an emergency services vehicle shall render its services to the persons needing the services, regardless of whether the vehicle is operating outside the vehicles normal jurisdictional boundaries. Nothing, so written in this agreement, shall in any way impair the service necessary for the protection of their municipalities.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, agreements, and conditions contained herein, it is hereby jointly agreed between Juneau County and the Orange ~~Town~~ City/Village of: _____, hereinafter referred to as "municipality," as follows:

1. That effective September 1st, 1992, the anticipated beginning of the E911 System in Juneau County, this agreement shall thereafter be applicable on a daily basis from said date through September 1st, 1993.

2. That if emergency services vehicle operated by the municipality, or operated by an agency with the municipality contracts for that particular emergency service, is dispatched in response to a request through the E911 system, such vehicle

(whether owned or operated by the municipality or by the agency) shall render its services to the persons needing the services, regardless of whether the vehicle is operating outside the vehicles normal jurisdictional (or as defined by contract) boundaries. Nothing, so written in this agreement, shall in any way impair services necessary for the protection of their municipalities.

3. NOW THEREFORE BE IT AGREED that this Unit of Municipality, by identification and proper signature, certifies approval of said system in this jurisdiction, be it further understood there shall be no direct cost of said system against this Unit of Municipality.

4. That a copy of this agreement shall be filed with the State Department of Justice and the State Department of Administration, as required by Sec. 146.70 (9) (c) Wis.Stats..
